## TSUUT'INA MUSEUM AND ARCHIVES SOCIETY

The circle has been chosen as the central theme of our museum because it is a sacred symbol. With out beginning or end, the circle represents the eternal continuity of life. It embraces all humanity and symbolizes the unity of all living things created by Nato, the Creator.

The past two hundred years have seen an end to the traditional way of life for the Tsuut'ina. The circle of life has been broken. The establishment of the Tsuut'ina Nation Museum marks a new beginning. Its is an attempt to preserve our culture for generations to come and to share who we are with others.

This Museum is dedicated to our ancestors and to our elders, for it is from them we have received a precious gift - Our History and Culture. The Tsuut'ina Nations Museum has an acknowledgement of that gift. It is a means of closing the circle once again.

*In 1983 The Sarcee Nation changed the name of the Nation back to the original name \*Tsuut'ina. It was originally spelled 'Tsuu T'ina' and split in two for phonetic purposes. In 2014 the name has gone back to the proper spelling we see today, TSUUT'INA.*
