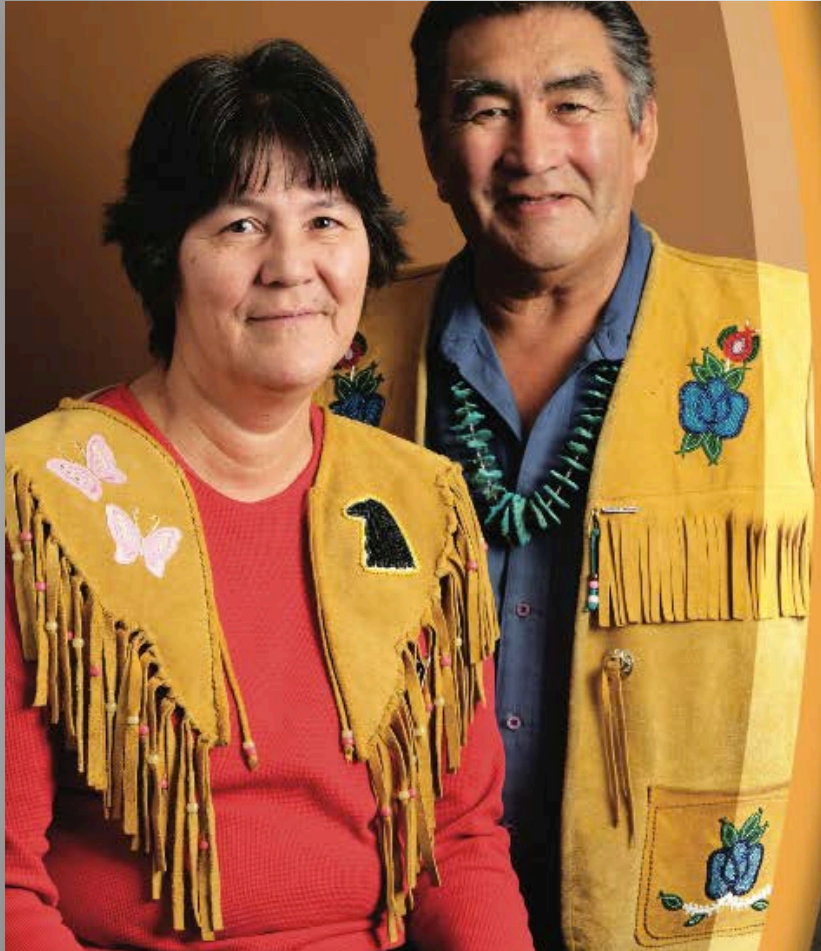

Yurt Lodge

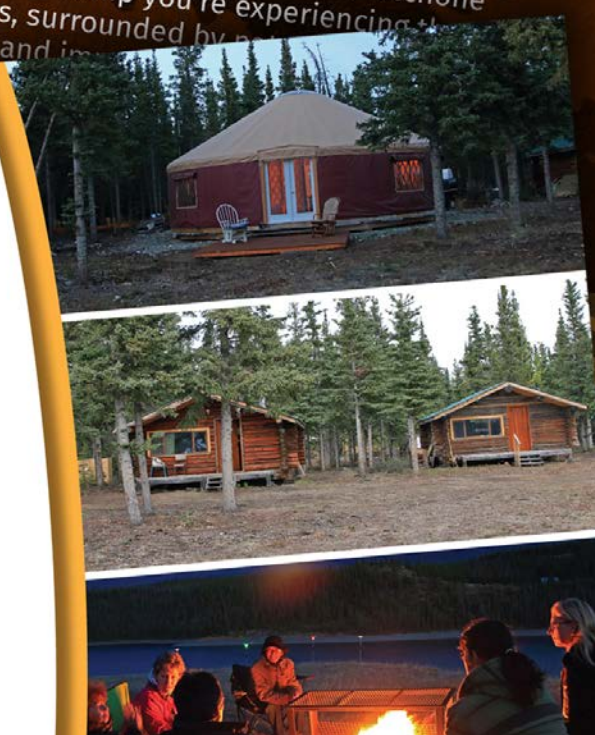

Guest Cabins
